

Germany stunned by neo-Nazi attacks

A neo-Nazi terrorist group which has been operating in Germany for more than a decade is suspected of being responsible for the murder of 10 people, more than a dozen bank robberies and a bomb attack

1 Düsseldorf, Jul 2000: Bomb attack at central train station injures group of former-Soviet Jews

2 Nuremberg, Sep 2000: Turkish flower shop owner shot dead

3 Nuremberg, Jun 2001: Turkish tailor killed with two shots to head

4 Hamburg, Jun 2001: Turkish greengrocer shot three times in head

5 Munich, Aug 2001: Second Turkish greengrocer shot twice in head

6 Rostock, Feb 2004: Doner kebab chef shot dead at his stand

7 Nuremberg, Jun 2005: Doner kebab shop owner shot dead

8 Munich, Jun 2005: Greek locksmith shot dead

9 Dortmund, Apr 2006: Turkish kiosk owner shot and killed in his shop

10 Kassel, Apr 2006: Turkish internet cafe owner shot dead



Heilbronn, Apr 25, 2007: German police officer **Michele Kiesewetter**, 22, shot dead. Her service pistol is later found in camper van in Eisenach

Hanover, Nov 13, 2011: Police arrest 37-year-old man – named only as **Holger G** – on suspicion of supplying group with fake documents and vehicles
