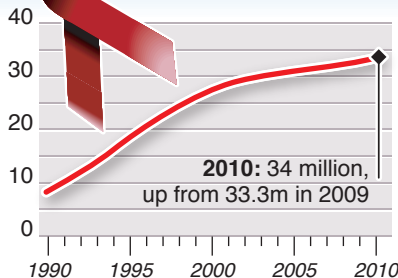


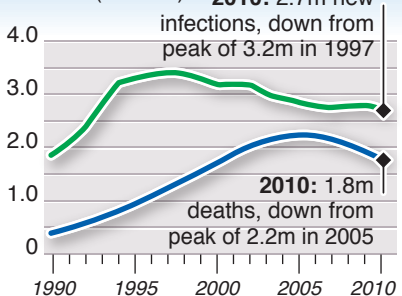
HIV numbers hit new high as drugs save lives

More people than ever are living with the AIDS virus but AIDS-related deaths are at their lowest level since their 2005 peak – down 21% – due to better access to drugs that keep HIV patients alive and well for many years
