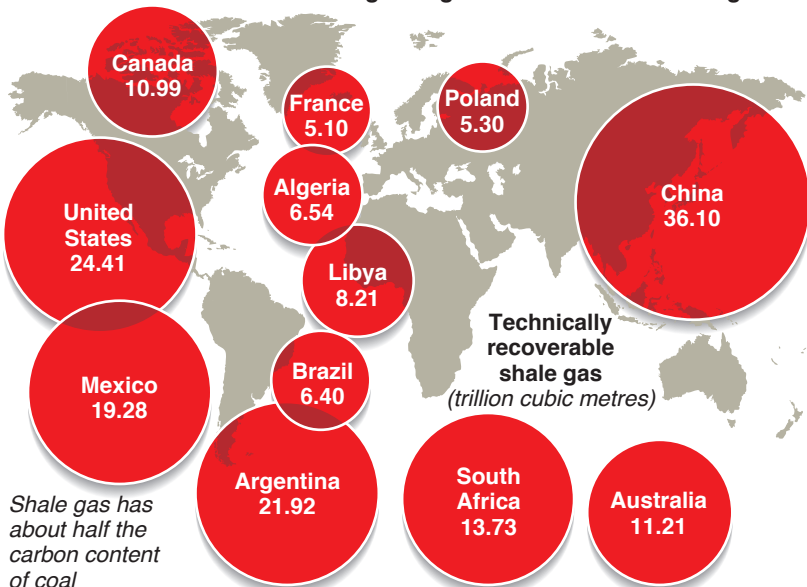


The “shale gale” natural gas revolution
