Fiji to end martial law



■ Dec 2006: Commodore Voreqe "Frank" Bainimarama (above) takes power in bloodless coup, ousting elected leader Laisenia Qarase. Australia, New Zealand, U.S. and European Union impose sanctions

■ Apr 2009: Bainimarama overturns constitution and imposes emergency law – including tight censorship on media and ban on public meetings – after Fiji Court of Appeal rules that military government is illegal. Fiji suspended from Commonwealth

■ Jan 2012: Emergency law to end
