1942: Born January 8,
in Oxford, England, on 300th

■ 1963: Diagnosed with motor neurone disease soon after arriving at Cambridge University to do PhD in cosmology

anniversary of Galileo's death

■ 1974: Calculates that black holes emit radiation, and eventually evaporate and disappear

■ 1979: Appointed *Lucasian Professor of Mathematics* at

Cambridge. Holds post for 30 years

■ 1985: Undergoes emergency tracheotomy after contracting pneumonia. Uses electronic voice synthesiser to communicate

■ 1988: Publishes *A Brief History of Time*, which sells over 10 million copies

2007: Makes sub-orbital spaceflight, becoming first quadriplegic to float in zero-gravity


