
Pentagon calls for slimmed-down military

President Barack Obama has announced a new defence strategy to create a leaner U.S. military – concentrating on Asian security risks and taking a back seat in Iraq and Afghanistan – as the Pentagon prepares to make \$487 billion in spending cuts over the next decade



Troop numbers: Army and Marine Corps personnel cut by 10-15 percent – loss of between 76,000 and 114.000 troops

Nuclear arsenal: Could be reduced, possibly by cutting number of nuclear-armed submarines
