- 1953: Born in Shaanxi province, son of *Xi Zhongxun*, one of Communist Party's founding fathers
- 1963: Father purged from power
- 1969: Xi sent to work for six years as "sent-down youth" during chaos
- of 1966-76 Cultural Revolution
- 1974: Joins Communist Party ■ 1987: Marries famous singer
- Peng Liyuan, his second marriage

 2000: Appointed provincial
 governor of Fujian province after
- helping clear up corruption scandal

 2007: Briefly Party Chief of
 Shanghai, then promoted to Standing
 Committee ruling inner circle
- 2008: Appointed vice-president
- 2010: Named vice-chair of Central Military Commission, which oversees People's Liberation Army
- Nov 2012: Becomes Communist Party chief. Xi Jinping will replace Hu Jintao as president of China in March
