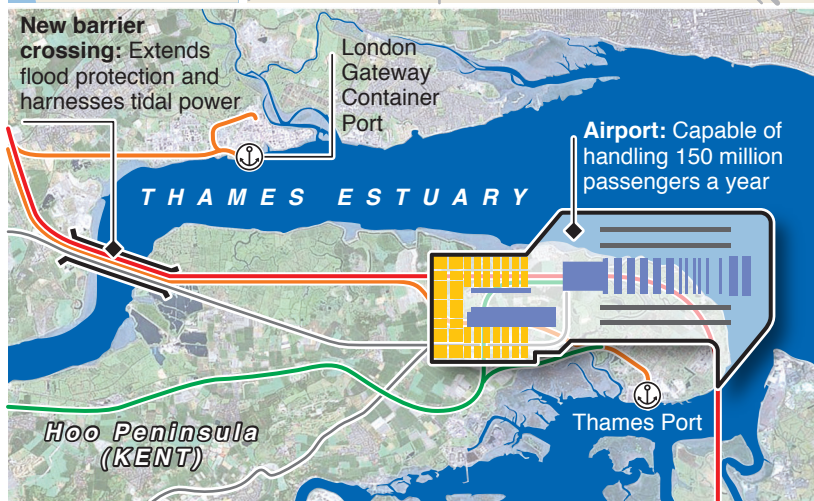
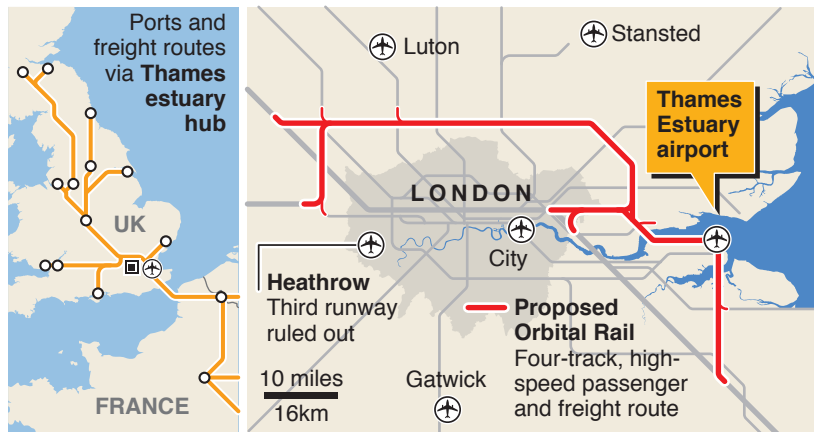


New hub airport for London considered
