Longest royal record holders

Queen Elizabeth II, the longest-reigning monarch in British history, still has some way to go to match other royal record holders past and present

Pepi II: Ancient Egyptian pharaoh succeeded to throne around 2278 BC at age six following premature death of father. Believed to have ruled for 94 years, longest reign of any monarch in history



Bhumibol Adulyadej 87-year-old Thai ruler is world's longest-serving current head of state. He became King *69 years* ago, in June 1946

Queen Victoria: Greatgreat-grandmother of Elizabeth II. Reign of 63 years and 216 days from 1837 to 1901 held British record until now



Louis XIV: King of France for 72 years (1643-1715), presided over period of great cultural and military expansion – longest reign in European history

Elizabeth II: Reign of more than 63 years now exceeds that of Victoria. Longestruling living monarch behind king of Thailand
