Britain's Queen Elizabeth II, poised to celebrate her Diamond Jubilee, still has some way to go to match other royal record holders past and present

Pepi II: Ancient Egyptian pharaoh succeeded to throne around 2278 BC at age six following premature death of father. Believed to have ruled for 94 years, longest reign of any monarch in history



Bhumibol Adulyadej 84-year-old Thai ruler is world's longest-serving current head of state – he became King over 65 years ago, in June 1946

Queen Victoria: Greatgreat-grandmother of Elizabeth II holds record as longest-reigning British monarch, ruling for nearly 64 years (1837-1901)



for 72 years (1643-1715), presided over period of great cultural and military expansion – longest reign in European history

Louis XIV: King of France

Elizabeth II: Ascended throne 60 years ago, putting her second on list of both longest-ruling British sovereigns, and current living monarchs
