

Thailand charges Iranian bomb suspects

Thailand has charged two Iranians over an alleged bomb plot in Bangkok which officials believe could be linked to attacks against Israeli diplomats in India and Georgia

1 Feb 13, Tbilisi, Georgia

Israeli embassy driver discovers bomb attached to underside of car. Device defused before it can go off

2 Feb 13, New Delhi

Four people wounded in attack on Israeli embassy car – including diplomat's wife and driver – after motorcycle rider attaches explosive device to door of vehicle

3 Feb 14, Bangkok: Two Iranian men arrested following series of explosions. Third man flees on flight to Malaysia. Magnets “similar” to those used in Georgia and India attacks found by police in house rented by Iranians

“Sticky” bomb: Explosive attached to powerful magnet (pictured), can detonate within five seconds of being stuck to vehicle
