Argentina train accidents

At least 73 people were killed and over 970 injured in rail accidents in Argentina over the past year. State-run TBA invests just 12% of its operating costs on maintenance



- and 675 injured after train crashes at Once Central station in capital Buenos Aires during rush hour
- Nov 2011: Bus carrying children hit by train. Eight schoolgirls killed
- Sep 2011: Bus crosses tracks in front of oncoming train, killing 11
- Apr 2011: About 70 passengers injured when train is hit by locomotive in Monasterio, outside Buenos Aires
- Feb 1, 1970: Worst rail accident in Argentine history kills more than 230 people when two trains collide at high speed in suburban Buenos Aires
