is sacred and destruction of any text containing the word Allah or verses from the Koran must be carried out with respect. Koran may be wrapped in shroud and buried in location with no foot traffic

Burning: Book may be burnt to ashes and dissolved in flowing water

Shredding: First runs or proofs of book during printing are never thrown away but are often shredded in a respectful manner
