Chen Guangchen profile



- 1971: Born in Shandong province, loses his sight after illness in infancy
- 2001: Returns to Shandong after studying at Nanjing University of Chinese Medicine enrols in law classes and begins giving free legal advice to villagers seeking assistance
- 2005: Rises to prominence after exposing programme of forced abortions and sterilisations as part of China's one-child policy
 - 2006: Jailed for four years for disrupting traffic after trial where he did not have access to defence lawyers
- 2010: Released from jail but placed under house arrest
- April 2012: Escapes house arrest and releases video addressed to Premier *Wen Jiabao* in which he demands investigation into mistreatment of his family
