

Zetas drug gang sets up Venezuela transit bases

Mexico's drug cartel the Zetas have teamed up with Colombia's Rastrojos to control much of the drugs moving into Venezuela, according to a new report. Together they have more influence in the drug trade than the Marxist rebels who have made the frontier area one of their strongholds
