

Rare chance to see Transit of Venus

Astronomers are preparing to view a rare planetary alignment when Venus passes across the disk of the sun, as seen from Earth. Transits of Venus occur in pairs with more than a century between each pair, and has been witnessed only seven times since the invention of the telescope in 1610

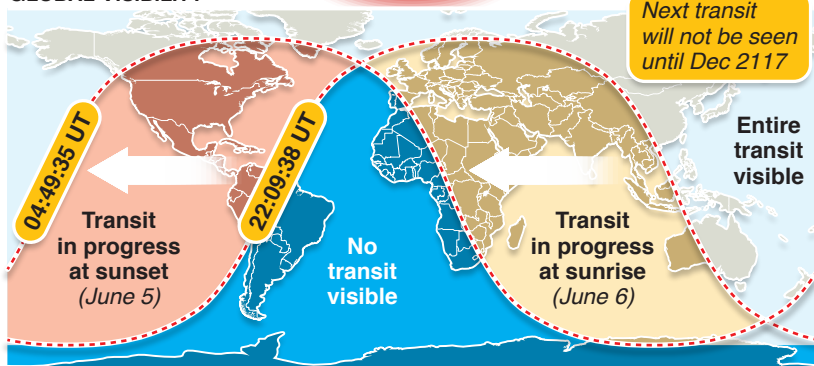
