▲ **U.S. singer and actress Judy Garland was born as Frances Gumm in Minnesota, U.S. She shot to fame in the film *The Wizard of Oz* (1939)**

1793: The Ménagerie du Jardin des Plantes, belonging to the botanical garden and the world's first public zoological garden, opened in Paris

1943: Hungarian journalist Laszlo Biro patented his ball-point pen

1967: The Six-Day War ended with Israel capturing East Jerusalem, the West Bank, Gaza Strip and the Sinai

1971: The U.S. formally ended its 20-year-old embargo on trade with China
