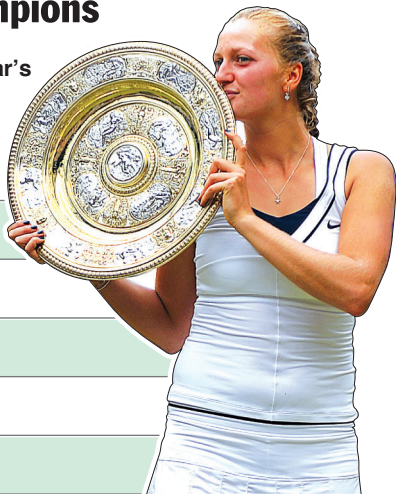


Wimbledon ladies' champions
