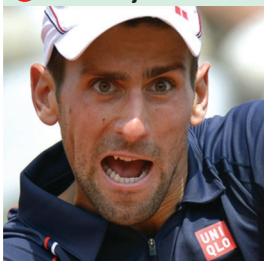


Wimbledon shaping up as No. 1 battleground
