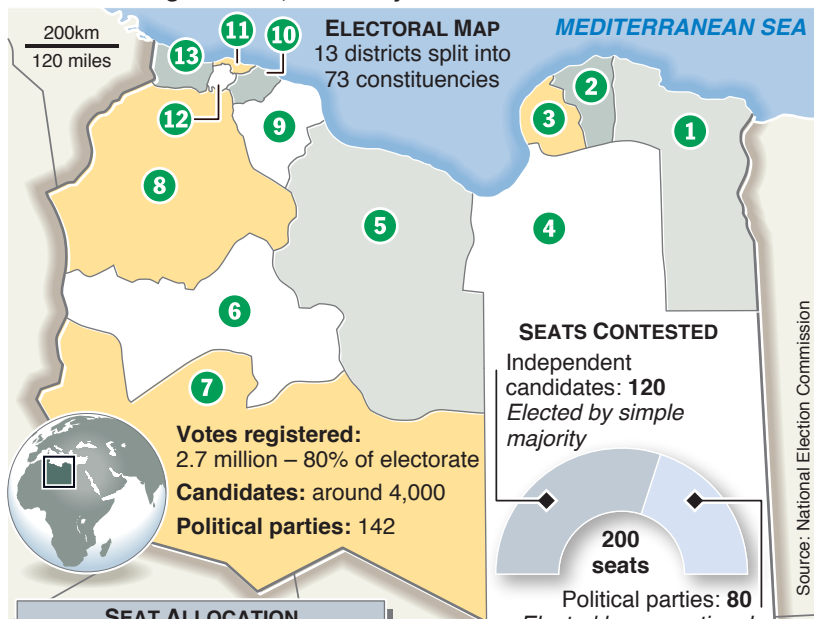


Libya votes in landmark election

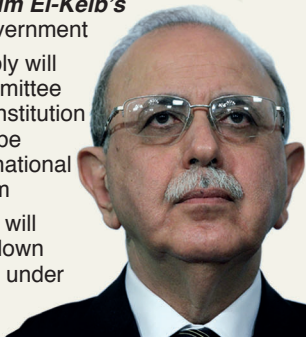
