

Peugeot to close Paris plant and cut jobs

Europe's second-biggest carmaker PSA Peugeot Citroën will slash 8,000 jobs and shut its Aulnay assembly plant – the first auto factory to close in France in 30 years – in an effort to stem widening operating losses

Aulnay, Paris: 3,300 jobs to go. Plant to shut by 2014.
3,600 non-assembly jobs to be cut across company

Rennes: 1,400 jobs to go. Production to be downsized

Mulhouse: BMW-Peugeot joint venture on verge of collapse

Sevelnord: Fiat to sell share of joint commercial vehicle venture by year's end. Assembles Jumpy, Expert and Fiat Scudo
