
Huge iceberg breaks off Greenland glacier

An iceberg twice the size of Manhattan has broken away from Greenland's Petermann Glacier, posing a fresh danger to North Atlantic shipping lanes and oil rigs off Canada's east coast. It is the second massive iceberg to calve from the glacier in less than two years
