Sikhism at a glance



- century in Punjab area straddling border between Pakistan and India – by *Guru Nanak* and subsequently led by succession of nine other Gurus
 - Fifth-largest organised religion in the world with over 30m followers including up to 500,000 in U.S.
- Sikh place of worship, called *gurdwara*, can be identified by flagpoles carrying Sikh flag. Most revered site is *Golden Temple* at Amritsar, India
- Observant Sikhs do not cut
 their hair. Male followers often wear
 turbans and do not shave their beards
- In Sep 2001, an Arizona gas station owner, *Balbir Singh Sodhi*, was shot dead by man said to be seeking revenge on Muslims for 9/11
