- Aug 6: Prime Minister Riad Farid Hijab (above left) defects to Jordan with his family. Premier Hijab joins opposition Syrian National Council
- Aug 4: General *Muhammed Faris*, first Syrian in space, flees to Turkey
- Jul 30: *Mohammad Hussam Hafez*, Syrian consul in Armenia, defects to opposition
- Jul 30: *Khaled al-Ayoubi*, Syria's top diplomat in London, defects
- Jul 30: Deputy police chief in western Syrian city of Latakia flees to Turkey, bringing number of generals defecting to over 20
- Jul 28: Farouk Taha, Ambassador to Belarus, joins Free Syrian Army
- Jul 26: *Ikhlas al-Badawi*, Aleppo MP and Assad loyalist, defects to Turkey with her children

- Jul 26: Mohammad Tahseen Faqir, Syrian military attaché in Oman, quits regime citing massacres committed by Assad forces
- Jul 24-25: Lamia al-Hariri, Syria's chargé d'affaires in Cyprus, and husband Abdelatif al-Dabbagh, ambassador to UAE, defect to Qatar
 - Jul 16: Maj Gen Adnan Silu, former head of Syria's chemical weapons programme, defects to Free Syrian Army
- Jul 11: Nawaf Fares, ambassador to Iraq, defects to Qatar
- Early July: Manaf Tlass (above right) Brigadier General of Syrian Republican Guard defects to France. A close confidant of President Assad, Tlass is seen as possible transitional leader
