Roger Federer (SUI)
ATP Rank: 1

Regained No.1 ranking with Wimbledon victory over Andy Murray – five-time U.S. Open champion, seeking first win at Flushing Meadows since 2008



Novak Djokovic (SRB) Rank: 2

Defending champion, yet to truly emulate superb 2011 season, securing only 3 titles at Australian Open, Miami and Canada



Andy Murray (GBR) Rank: 4

Olympic gold medalist, defeating Federer in straight sets – yet to win major title, despite making final four at 6 of last 7 Grand Slams



Jo-Wilfried Tsonga (FRA) Rank: 6

Looking to reach first Grand Slam final since 2008 – made QF at Roland Garros and SF at Wimbledon



Juan Martin del Potro (ARG) Rank: 8

Won 2009 U.S. Open, strong in 2012 having twice made Slam QFs and SFs at Olympics, Madrid and Cincinnati
