▲ **Australia's “dingo baby” trial, in which Lindy and Michael Chamberlain were charged with the murder of their nine-week-old daughter Azaria, began**

1847: U.S. General Winfield Scott led his forces at the Battle of Chapultepec leading to the capture of Mexico City

1943: Having been Generalissimo since 1928, Chiang Kai-shek was elected President of China
