

Top gadgets from 50 years of James Bond movies



▶ **The Golden Gun**
Assembled by arch-villain **Scaramanga** in *The Man With The Golden Gun* – using pen, cufflink, cigarette lighter and cigarette case. Fires single golden bullet

▶ **Lotus Esprit**
(*The Spy Who Loved Me*): Transforms into submarine complete with periscope, sonar and surface-to-air missiles



▶ **Aston Martin V12 Vanquish**
(*Die Another Day*): With auto-targeting shotguns, tyre spikes, ejector seat and adaptive camouflage for total invisibility

▶ **Omega Seamaster watch**: First worn by 007 in *Goldeneye*. Includes laser cutting beam hidden in dial, grappling hook and remote detonator



▶ **Bell Jet Pack**: Two foldable hydrogen peroxide fuel tanks strapped to Bond's back aid his escape in opening scene of *Thunderball*



▶ **Q-Boat**: Prototype borrowed by 007 for Thames river chase in *The World Is Not Enough*. Equipped with jet propulsion, torpedoes and dive function

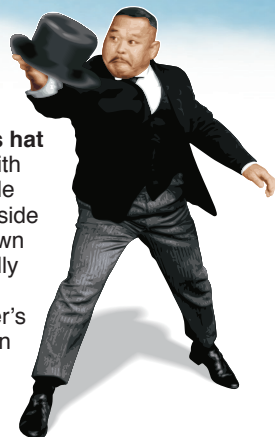
▶ **"Little Nellie"**: Heavily-armed autogyro assembled from four large suitcases. Piloted by Bond in *You Only Live Twice*



▶ **Aston Martin DB5**
Signature car first appeared in *Goldfinger* – sporting tyre shredders, smoke screen, machine guns, bulletproof glass and ejector seat



▶ **Oddjob's hat**
Bowler with steel blade hidden inside rim. Thrown with deadly effect by Goldfinger's henchman

▶ **Ericsson cell phone**
20,000-volt stun gun and fingerprint scanner. Also allows 007 to remotely drive his BMW 750iL in *Tomorrow Never Dies*



▶ **Walther PPK**
Bond's weapon of choice from *Dr. No* to *Tomorrow Never Dies* (except *Moonraker* and *Octopussy*), and again in *Quantum of Solace* and *Skyfall*



▶ **Bond returns on Oct 23 for his 23rd film** outing in *Skyfall*. Among his tech gear will be a palmprint-recognition Walther PPK that only he can fire
