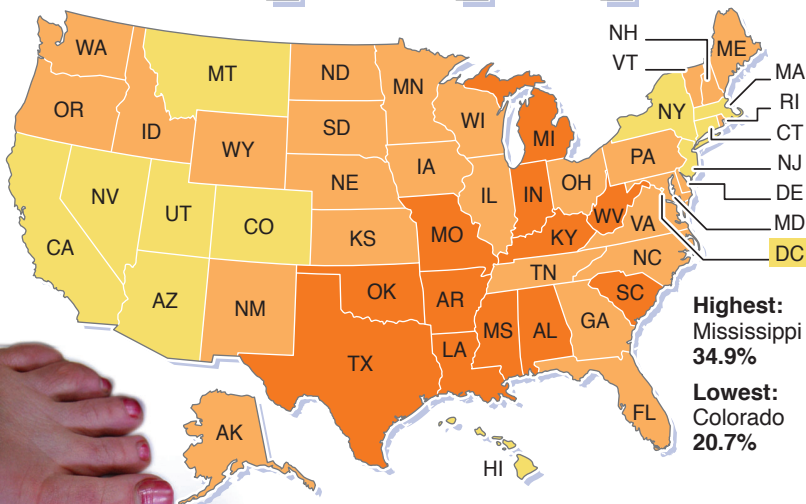


U.S. obesity rates projected to rise by 2030

A group campaigning against obesity predicts that over half of people in 39 U.S. states will be obese by 2030. Two-thirds of Americans are overweight now, which includes 36 percent of people who are obese

Under 25% 25-30% Over 30%

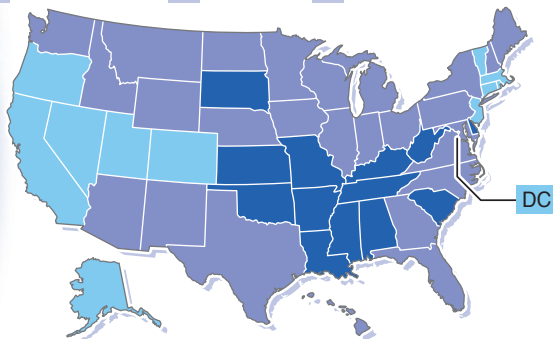
