

Protests over anti-Islam film



Sep 11: U.S. embassy in Cairo, Egypt, attacked. Mob storms U.S. consulate in Benghazi, Libya, killing U.S. Ambassador **Chris Stevens** and three other Americans

Sep 12: Anti-U.S. protests take place in several Arab countries

Sep 13: Protesters break into U.S. embassy compound in Sanaa, Yemen, where clashes with police kill four people. Protesters stone U.S. mission in Cairo

Sep 14: At least seven people killed as protests spread around the world

Sep 15: Taliban militants attack NATO's heavily fortified Camp Bastion in Afghanistan, in backlash over film, killing two U.S. marines

Sep 16: Hezbollah leader **Sheikh Hassan Nasrallah** calls for week of protests in Lebanon as demonstrations continue in many countries and in some European capitals

Sep 17: Protest in countries including Pakistan, where two people die in clashes between protesters and police

Sep 18: Suicide car bombing in Kabul kills 12 people, nine of them foreigners, in deadliest single attack to date, as vengeance for film

Sep 19: Security stepped up at many of France's embassies after French satirical magazine publishes obscene cartoons of Prophet Muhammad
