

Nuclear sabotage – claims and counterclaims

1 Jan 2007, Isfahan: *Dr. Ardeshir Hosseinpour* dies mysteriously while working at uranium hexafluoride plant

2 2008: U.S. *President Bush* authorises covert *Olympic Games* programme to disrupt Iran's electrical and computer networks, later expanded by *President Obama*

3 Jun 2009: Nuclear scientist *Shahram Amiri* disappears from Saudi Arabia, later appears in U.S., claiming kidnap by CIA

4 Nov 2009-Jan 2010, Natanz: Up to 1,000 centrifuges at main uranium-enrichment facility destroyed after Siemens software attacked by *Stuxnet* computer worm, a U.S.-Israeli product of *Olympic Games*

5 Jan 2010, Tehran: Nuclear physicist *Massoud Ali Mohammadi* killed by remote-controlled bomb

6 Nov, Tehran: *Dr. Fereydoun Abbasi-Davani* – later head of *Atomic Energy Organisation of Iran* – survives bomb attack. Engineer *Majid Shahriari* killed in blast

7 Jul 2011, Tehran: Physicist *Daryoush Rezaei* shot outside home

8 Nov 12, Bidganeh: *Gen. Hassan Moghaddam* (right) – father of Iran's missile programme – killed in explosion at missile base

9 Nov 28, Isfahan: Explosion near uranium conversion plant



10 Jan 11, 2012, Tehran: Nuclear scientist *Mostafa Ahmadi Roshan* killed in bomb attack

11 May 29: *Flame* spy virus found to have been targeting Iran's oil industry for past five years

12 Aug 17, Fordow: Power lines from Qom allegedly cut using explosives a day before IAEA visit. Similar attack takes place at Natanz

13 Sep 23, Tehran: Siemens accused of selling equipment containing explosives to sabotage nuclear facilities. Denies any such business ties
