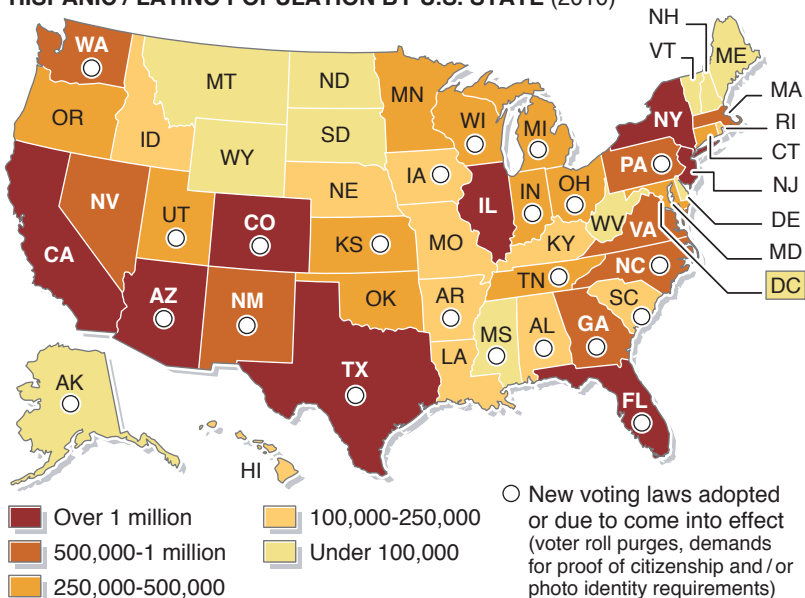


U.S. voting laws may deter 10m Hispanics

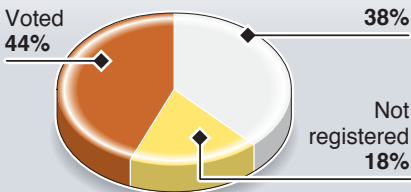
Changes to voting laws in several states may hinder at least 10 million Hispanic citizens from casting their ballots, civil rights advocates warn in a new report. Hispanics are considered pivotal to the U.S. presidential election and could sway the outcome in several swing states
