Nepal plane crash

A plane flying on route to Mount Everest has crashed shortly after takeoff from Kathmandu, killing all 19 people on board, including seven British and five Chinese



Sep 28: *Sita Air* plane heading for Lukla – hub for trekking in Everest region – crashes into river bank

- Sep 2011: 19 people killed when Buddha Air plane crashes during flight to view Mount Everest
- May 14, 2012: Plane crashes while trying to land at Jomsom airport, claiming 15 lives
- Sep 23: At least 11 die in avalanche on Mount Manaslu
