▲ **British politician Margaret Thatcher was born. Leader of the Conservative party, she became Britain's first woman prime minister in 1979**

**1884:** Greenwich was established as the universal time meridian of longitude from which standard times throughout the world are calculated

**1962:** Drama critics applauded the opening in New York of Edward Albee's first full-length play, "Who's Afraid of Virginia Woolf"

**1963:** Beatlemania was born when The Beatles appeared at the London Palladium, attracting thousands of screaming teenagers
