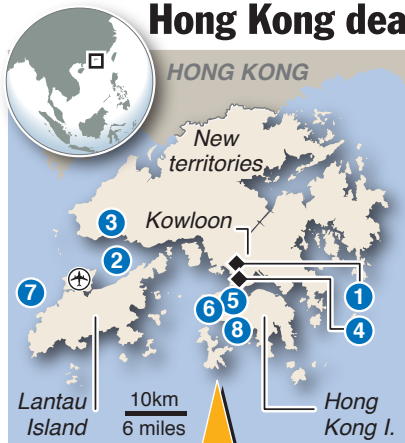


Hong Kong deadliest accidents



Oct 1, 2012: At least 38 die after boat carrying over 120 people to fireworks display collides with ferry and sinks near Lamma Island in Hong Kong's deadliest boat accident in 40 years

1 2011: Fire in Kowloon street market kills nine people, injures 34, and leaves 118 others homeless

2 2008: Oil rig supply ship sinks after colliding with bulk freighter off Lantau Island, killing 18 people

3 2003: Truck hits bus which plunges down 30-metre slope in Tuen Mun, killing 21 people

4 1996: Blaze in 16-story building on Nathan Road claims 41 lives

5 1993: 21 people, mainly teenagers, killed in stampede in Lan Kwai Fong on New Year's Eve

6 1972: Landslide at Po Shan Road destroys 12-story apartment building, killing 67 people

7 1971: Hong Kong-Macau ferry sinks when Typhoon Rose hits Hong Kong, killing 88 passengers and crew

8 1971: Fire at Jumbo floating restaurant before its opening kills 34 workers
