

China firm sues Obama over wind farms

A Chinese-owned company is suing President Barack Obama after he blocked a wind farm deal on national security grounds. The lawsuit alleges that the U.S. president "acted in an unlawful and unauthorised manner" in stopping the project near a Navy base in Oregon
