▲ Irish statesman Eamon De Valera was born. He was president of Sinn Fein, prime minister, and then president of the Republic of Ireland until 1973

1884: George Eastman obtained a patent for paper photographic film that could be rolled in a canister

1962: The U.S. obtained photographic evidence of Soviet missiles stationed in Cuba

1991: Burmese opposition leader Aung San Suu Kyi, was awarded the Nobel Peace Prize

2002: The European Commission ruled that only cheese made in Greece could be called feta
