▲ **The Occupy Wall Street movement, that began as an organized protest in New York's financial district, expanded to other major U.S. and international cities**

**1915:** American playwright Arthur Miller, known for *The Crucible* and *Death of a Salesman*, was born

**1989:** The worst earthquake since 1906 struck San Francisco, killing 67 and injuring more than 600

**1998:** Former Chilean dictator General Augusto Pinochet was arrested in London on charges of genocide

**2007:** Turkey's parliament approved a request for troops to cross the Iraqi border to attack Kurdish rebels
