► **HOT LICKS LOGO**
Designed by art student **John Pasche** in 1970 following approach by Mick Jagger, who was unimpressed by designs presented by record label Decca. Encapsulating Jagger's lips and band's rebellious image, it was first used on **Sticky Fingers** album and has been in use ever since
