*October 29, 1922*

▲ **Prices collapsed amid panic selling on the New York Stock Exchange. This “Wall Street Crash” heralded the start of America’s Great Depression**

**1787:** Mozart’s opera Don Giovanni was first performed in Prague

**1923:** Turkey became a republic under its first president, nationalist leader Kemal Ataturk

**1958:** The first coronary angiogram, a diagnostic x-ray procedure to visualize blockage of the small arteries to the heart, was performed

**1998:** John Glenn, 77, returned to space 36 years after becoming the first American to orbit the Earth
