

Key figures in Petraeus sex scandal



■ **David Petraeus**, 60.

Touted as potential presidential candidate, ended 37-year army career in 2011 as highly regarded

four-star general. Resigned as CIA director after admitting extramarital affair with **Paula Broadwell**

Tendered resignation in week of Obama's re-election when affair became public



■ **Paula Broadwell**, 40.

Former military officer and academic researcher, gained access to Petraeus in 2006 when

assigned to write his biography. Their affair began in late 2011

Affair revealed by FBI investigation into anonymous emails from Broadwell to Jill Kelley, warning her to stay away from Petraeus



■ **Jill Kelley**, 37.

Florida socialite, hosted parties for U.S. Central Command in Tampa when Petraeus was commander there from

2008-10. No suggestion that Kelley had extramarital affair

Enmeshed in scandal with revelation of extensive email correspondence – some allegedly inappropriate – with Gen. Allen

■ **Natalie Khawam**, 37.

Kelley's twin sister, enlisted support of Petraeus and Allen in her bitter child custody dispute. **Both generals wrote letters in support of Khawam**



■ **General John Allen**, 58.

Four-star Marine general, succeeded Petraeus as top U.S. and NATO commander in Afghanistan in 2011. Under

investigation over "flirtatious" emails to Kelley from 2010. Denies wrongdoing

Will remain in post while probe is under way but appointment as Supreme Allied Commander in Europe is now on hold

■ **Unidentified FBI agent**

Triggered probe after Kelley told him of threatening emails she received.

Removed from investigation after sending her shirtless photo of himself
