1. Xi Jinping, 59: New Communist Party boss will replace *President Hu Jintao* in March. *Princeling* son of revolutionary is considered a cautious reformer

2. Li Keqiang, 57: Takes over number two spot, replacing *Wen Jiabao* as premier. Showed reform-minded leadership while studying law at Peking University













3. Zhang Dejiang, 65: Conservative. Protege of economic reformer, former president *Jiang Zemin*

4. Yu Zhengsheng, 67: Shanghai party boss. Flexible to reform

5. Liu Yunshan, 65: Conservative. Appointed *propaganda tsar*

6. Wang Qishan, 64: Reformer. Will head anti-corruption agency

7. Zhang Gaoli, 65: Reformer
