

# Fears rise over ground incursion into Gaza

Israeli troops and Hamas militants have engaged in fresh fighting despite a temporary ceasefire put in place during a visit to Gaza by Egypt's Prime Minister, as preparations for a possible ground assault get underway

At least 21 Palestinians and three Israelis have been killed since Israel began its offensive on Wednesday

Militants say they have launched over 350 rockets – Israel claims 145 intercepted by Iron Dome missile defence system
