*July 23, 1962*

▲ The first TV telecommunications satellite, Telstar, relayed the first live satellite broadcast from Maine, U.S. to the Pleumeur-Bodou Telecom Center, Brittany, France

**1865:** Brunel's steamship, the Great Eastern, began laying a new Atlantic communications cable to replace the original one

**1933:** British architect Sir Richard Rogers, designer of the Pompidou Centre in Paris and the Lloyd's building in London, was born

**2004:** An exact replica of the 400-year-old Ottoman bridge in Mostar was reopened. The original was destroyed during the Bosnian war
