

- Dec 5, 1932: Richard Wayne
  Penniman born in Macon, Georgia
   1955: Boogie woogie rhythms of
- Tutti Frutti generate first smash hit

  1957: Quits at height of his fame
- 1957: Quits at height of his fame to become born-again Christian
- 1962: Returns to rock music, inspiring *Beatles, Rolling Stones*, and *Jimi Hendrix*, among others
- 1970s: Battles drug and alcohol addiction
- 1984: Finally able to reconcile roles as evangelist and rock 'n' roll artist
- 2012: Rolling Stone Magazine declares Tutti Frutti's *A-wop-bop-a-loo-mop-a-lop-bam-boom!* is still most inspired rock lyric on record
