December 20, 1812

▲ Brothers Jacob and Wilhelm Grimm published their first collection of classic German folk tales including Cinderella, Snow White, and Little Red Riding Hood

1820: The U.S. state of Missouri levied a tax against bachelors

1991: The Folies Bergere, a popular Paris nightspot since 1869, closed down

2001: President Fernando de la Rúa of Argentina resigned after the financial crisis led to two days of violent protests

2002: The United States positioned itself to go to war by declaring that Iraq was in “material breach” of UN Security Council Resolution 1441
