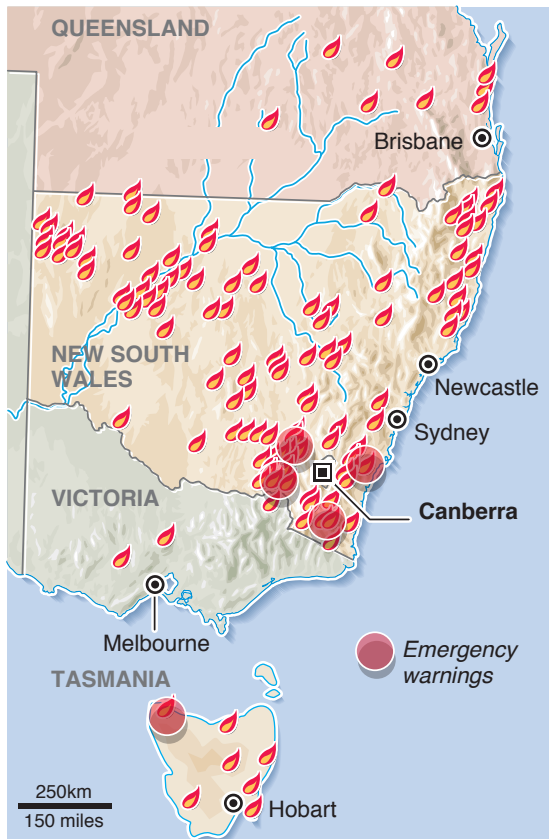


“Catastrophic” Australian bush fires

With over 100 bush fires raging in southeast Australia and temperatures soaring over 40°C, four regions in New South Wales have been given a “catastrophic” danger rating. Remarkably, there have been no fatalities



FIRE DANGER RATINGS

New “catastrophic” rating introduced to include uncontrollable fires where evacuation is only option

Catastrophic
Uncontrollable. Leave immediately, do not attempt to protect property

Extreme
Only try to defend homes assessed by firefighters as defensible

Severe
Only assessed homes should be defended

Very high
Difficult to control

High
Controllable fires

Low
Easily controlled
