

2013 Australian Open – men's preview



Novak Djokovic (SRB)
Rank: 1

Three-time Australian Open champion, defeated Nadal in epic five-set encounter last year. Strong finish to 2012, winning ATP World Tour finals



Roger Federer (SUI) *Rank: 2*

Has made semi-final or better at Australian Open each year since 2004 – rebound best form in 2012, adding 17th Grand Slam title



Andy Murray (GBR) *Rank: 3*

Victory at U.S Open secured first Grand Slam title in wake of Olympic triumph. Won first tournament of 2013 in Brisbane



David Ferrer (ESP) *Rank: 5*

Career-best season in 2012, reaching semis or quarters in all four majors – lost in QF to Djokovic in Melbourne



Tomas Berdych (CZE) *Rank: 6*

Australian Open quarter-finalist for past two seasons – made U.S. Open semi-final in final Slam of 2012
