*February 26, 1935*

▲ **The potential of Radar (radio detection and ranging) to detect aircraft was demonstrated by Robert Watson-Watt to the British Air Ministry**

**1990:** The Soviet Union agreed to withdraw all its 73,500 troops from Czechoslovakia by the following July

**1993:** A terrorist bomb at the World Trade Centre in New York killed six people

**1995:** Barings Bank, Britain's oldest merchant bank, collapsed after trader Nick Leeson ran up losses of \$1.4 billion

**2007:** The International Court of Justice ruled that Serbia was guilty of failing to prevent genocide in the Srebrenica
