Nov 2006: Unprecedented security

- Oct: Beatifies 498 martyrs from Spanish Civil War in ceremony at Vatican, setting all-time record
- Apr 2008: Meets with sex abuse victims from Boston Archdiocese during official visit to U.S.
- Jul: Visits Australia to participate in World Youth Day. Makes historic full apology for child sex abuse
- Dec: In end of year message to Roman Curia Pope talks about gender distinctions between men and women and "asks that this order, set down by creation, be respected"
- Jan 2009: Launches Vatican channel on YouTube

- Palestinian Territories, where he condemns Holocaust denials and calls for cooperation between Palestinians and Israelis
- Nov: Signs apostolic constitution Anglicanorum Coetibus which enables Anglicans to enter into full communion with Catholic Church
- Apr 2010: Faces allegations that as cardinal, he was responsible for delaying Church action against convicted paedophile priest in 1985
- May 2012: Pope's butler arrested for leaking Vatican documents exposing corruption. Pope Benedict later pardons him
- Dec: During Christmas speech he reiterates that marriage should be defended from "every possible misrepresentation"
- Feb 11, 2013: Pope Benedict XVI announces he is to resign on Feb 28
