Earlier Papal resignations

■ Clement I (92?-101). Allegedly gave up pontificate for sake of peace



- Pontian (230-35).
 Resigned after being exiled to mines of Sardinia during persecution of Christians by Roman Emperor Maximinus
 Thrax
- Marcellinus (296-304).
 Abdicated or deposed after complying with Roman Emperor Diocletian's order to offer sacrifice to pagan gods
- Martin I (649-55). Exiled by Byzantine Emperor *Constans II*
- Benedict V (964). Accepted deposition by Holy Roman Emperor Otto I after one month in office

Benedict IX (1032-45). Resigned after selling papacy to Gregory VI



■ **Gregory VI** (1045-46). Deposed for simony – paying for sacraments – by Holy Roman Emperor *Henry III*



◆ Celestine V (1294): After five months in office, issued solemn decree declaring it permissible for pope to resign. Lived two more years as hermit – later canonized

Resigned at request of Council of Constance to help end Great Western Schism

Benedict XVI (2005-13). First pope to resign in 600 years
